THE UNDERSIGNED AGREES TO ASSUME ALL LIABILITY AND SHALL INDEMNIFY AND SAVE THE BOROUGH, ITS SUBDIVISIONS, DEPARTMENTS, AGENTS, AND EMPLOYEES, HARMLESS FROM DAMAGES OR LOSSES SUSTAINED BY VEHICLES WHILE BEING TOWED, STORED OR RELEASED FROM WRECKER'S POSSESSION AND FROM ALL PERSONAL INJURIES AND PROPERTY DAMAGE OCCURRING TO ANY PERSONS, OR PROPERTY, AS A RESULT OF THE PERFORMANCE OF THE WRECKER'S SERVICES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, TOWING, STORAGE, OR OTHER SUCH ACTIVITIES RELATING TO THE LICENSED WRECKER'S SERVICES. ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE RELEASE OF A STORED VEHICLE SHALL BE ON THE WRECKER ONLY.
